Sponsorship News: As we anticipate successful Walks in Garden City this fall, it is important to remember that sponsorship is the life blood of the Emmaus movement. There is a real need for all of us as Christians to be aware of the people around us who might be considered potential Christian leaders. Keep in mind that most times “prospects” do not agree to participate the first time they are asked. They need time and more information. It may seem early to approach a prospective Pilgrim; however, starting now gives them plenty of time to pray and think about their decision. There are several duties as a sponsor. Some duties focus on your responsibility as a sponsor and some are the Pilgrim’s responsibility. • Pray: Prayer should focus on how this person can be a more vital and alive Christian. It should not just focus on how to get this person to attend the weekend. • Appointment: Make an appointment to extend the invitation. Be sure to include both husband and wife in the invitation. • Equal commitment: Both husband and wife should make an equal commitment to attend. • Application: Have your Pilgrims fill out the application form in your presence. Each applicant should fill be sure to fill out each blank. • Continuing preparation: Continue to pray and stay in contact, answering any questions they may have up to their weekend. The website is all set up and even an old guy like me can figure it out! Log onto the website <http://breadoflifecommunity.com/> and click on “sponsorship info” and then select what you want –“applications” or “sponsorship information”. The one thing to remember is that if you are a first year Pilgrim you need a co-sponsor to help you sponsor a new Pilgrim. Check with your own sponsor for help.
