Welcome Pilgrims of Walks 129 & 130 to the Bread of Life Walk to Emmaus! In welcoming you to the community, I hope by now your sponsors have integrated you into a regular reunion group and a local community gathering. Should you have trouble finding either, feel free to contact me or any member of the Emmaus Community to assist you in your 4th days!

I would like to welcome some additional new individuals to the Bread of Life Community Board of Directors. Marsha Jarboe will be serving as our new Treasurer; Judi McKinney has come on board in Snacks department; and Carol King in Agape.

During our March meeting, the board reviewed the Spring Walks and read evaluations from the pilgrims and team members. We appreciate your candor and time. Your comments have been acknowledged and we will strive to implement them prior to the Fall 2018 walks.

As the community serves a large geographic area of the state of Kansas, we find ourselves moving equipment from one walk location to the next and back again. In the past we have rented enclosed trailers to accommodate moving all of the equipment necessary to hold a set of walk weekends, team meetings, etc. To that end, the board has approved the purchase of a 20 to 24 foot enclosed trailer to accommodate the needs. This will prevent us from having to reserve one several months in advance and then driving to the location of the trailer to pick it up, load, move, unload, etc. The moving of this equipment from location to location falls to the Facilities Chair on our board. As a volunteer to be cognizant of his or her travel time from their home to our walk locations also factors in to this process and would help to ease the burden on that individual. To this end, the board anticipates this to be in the neighborhood of five-thousand dollar purchase and would appreciate any assistance the community could donate to help offset this cost.
