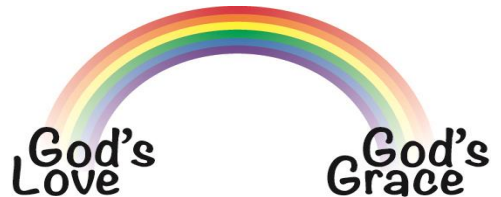
From the REGISTRAR:
